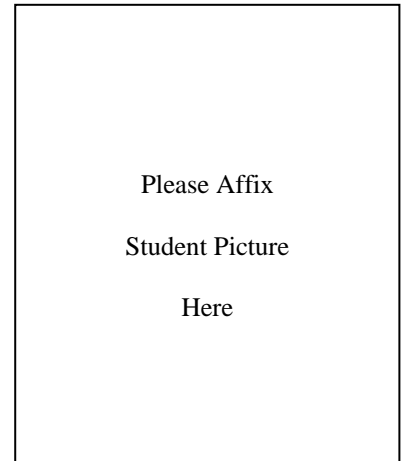

HOUSING FORM

GEA provides you with accommodation during your whole stay in France from June 2nd (early arrival) to July 16th morning (check out time), at the different locations of the classes (Toulouse + Poitiers) and organized visits (Marseille, Bayonne-Basque country) at no extra cost (cost included in the program fee).

- Toulouse: Student Residence Hall (standard single dorm rooms)
- Poitiers, Marseille and Bayonne: budget hotels (2 to 4 persons hotel rooms).

Would you decide to spend a week-end somewhere else, it would be under your responsibility to organize it at your own expense.

***REMEMBER:** Breakfast and lunch are included during school days only. Dinners are not included and can be purchased at the school cafeterias at an inexpensive price. (Note: You are responsible for ALL your meals on the weekends).*

During the organised weekends in Marseille and Bayonne, breakfasts only are included.

PAYMENT

A **625 €deposit** is required along with the completed application form.

Please submit your application (original copies only) along with the necessary attachments (photo, transcript, insurance card and 625 €deposit) by **JANUARY, 15 2009** to be considered for the program.

The remaining balance of 1,875 €is due at the latest on the first official day of the program: **Friday, June 5, 2009.**

Credit cards or cash are the only acceptable methods of payment for settling the balance of your account.

RELEASE STATEMENT:

I understand that I am ultimately responsible for my own behaviour during this exchange, and am aware that any unruly and disturbing behaviour may be grounds for immediate expulsion from the program.

I understand that I am financially responsible for providing my meals not included in the program, visa fees (if applicable) and any other miscellaneous costs (not specified in the program description) involved in living abroad for an extended period of time.

I understand that by accepting admission to this program I am making a commitment to observe and obey the rules and regulations of my home university _____ as well as the host universities of the GEA program, and that I am a responsible representative of both.
